IMAGE SOURCES:

CRIA/AIRS images consist of (1) copyrighted images originating with Jay Robert Nash, or (2) images that were originally in public domain before being uniquely scanned and post-processed by CRIA/AIRS and then copyrighted (under the name of Jay Robert Nash Collection), as well as other collections (such as the Derek Fell Horticultural Image Collection, which is under exclusive contract to CRIA/AIRS). The Jay Robert Nash Collection began more than four decades ago when, at great expense, Mr. Nash and his researchers began collecting, assembling, organizing and indexing historical images, either from his own archives or from public domain archives. In addition, Mr. Nash established a worldwide CRIA/AIRS network of accredited engineers, architects and historians who then and now photograph (with high-end resolution digital cameras) important structures (buildings of all sorts, bridges, dams, etc.), historical landmarks, waterways, ships, mountains/volcanoes, exhibits of paintings and sculpture in public galleries, and many exhibits in public institutions, as well as present and past personalities in many fields of endeavor. Further, illustrators employed by CRIA/AIRS provide creative contemporary images for many worldwide personalities.

Other CRIA/AIRS images, originating or coming into the public domain, have been obtained over a period of several decades from thousands of non-commercial worldwide (local, state, federal) government/military/law enforcement/intelligence/fire department agencies, social, religious and humanitarian organizations, as well as worldwide historical associations and organizations (see U.S. state-by-state listings below); public aquariums, archives, art galleries, botanical gardens, marine institutions, museums, parks; planetariums, and zoos (see U.S. state/city listings below); defunct periodicals; or out-of-copyright books (most of these works dating back 100 years or more).

CRIA/AIRS images originating or coming into public domain are copyrighted after CRIA/AIRS has uniquely scanned, sized, scaled, cleaned (and in some cases colorized) the images. Through this procedural imprimatur process, all such images are proprietary and copyrightable to the Jay Robert Nash Collection.

CRIA/AIRS makes no separate identifications (citations) of original public domain hard copy images in order to protect its continued (through anticipated repeated use of the same image offered online to users either at sale through CRIA or subscription to schools and libraries. All CRIA/AIRS images have invisible watermarks identifying their copyrights.

The following non-commercial sources from which historic public domain images have been retrieved include but are not limited to:

American Civil War:

Complete photographic works of all Civil War photographers—Brady, Gardner, Meserve and others—whose images are in public domain, along with all images, illustrations, paintings, portraits and maps appearing in all newspapers and periodicals of that era, and in all state and city museums and historical societies, as well as the National Archives and which are also in public domain. CRIA/AIRS is currently scanning all of these images.

Books (out of print and out of copyright):

Images in all deep historical subjects and categories from the more than 500,000 printed volumes in the Jay Robert Nash book library, most of which consists of rare books that are a century old or more and are no longer in copyright and for which all images are in public domain, are presently being scanned by CRIA/AIRS.

Defunct Periodicals:

Complete collections of hundreds of worldwide defunct periodicals dating back several hundred years. All of the images contained therein are out of copyright and in public domain, and these include such general interest American 19th Century publications as Frank Leslie's Weekly (AKA: Leslie's Weekly), Harper's Weekly, Police Gazette, and Century Magazine, to name a few. All of these periodicals offer deep historical images of maps, illustrations, and photos from their earliest type on all subjects (hundreds of thousands of images that CRIA/AIRS is presently scanning).

Within this collection are scores of defunct motion picture periodicals now in public domain, 1900s-1970s, yielding hundreds of thousands of copyright free images (advertisements, portraits of film personnel and scenes from motion pictures).

Included in this collection are more recent periodicals containing thousands of historic and contemporary images published directly by Jay Robert Nash: Literary Times (1961-1968), a journal of the fine arts; ChicagoLand Magazine (1968-1970), Chicago's first city magazine; CrimeFacts (1988-1994), a criminal justice monthly review and the author's national column, Crime Journal, syndicated widely by King Features (1972-1995). Nash holds direct copyright on all content for these periodicals and that column, including all images published under those separate imprimaturs.
